BEACONSFIELD LIGHTS

RMS has indicated their preferred option. Option 3 relies on the use of signs only (no physical islands) to prohibit entry into Ralston St from Beaconsfield Rd. This is the least expensive option and has been successfully implemented at many similar intersections. (An example being the treatment at the Gore Hill Freeway exit at the Pacific Highway where entry into Howarth Rd is prohibited)

Council forwarded a project brief to a traffic planning consultancy to provide traffic data collection, traffic modelling, and analysis services of the existing situation and option 3. We are not sure what they will learn that they haven't already learned from the previous several studies, but it's progress, so we are not going to try to stop them. Anyway, the consultants notified Council yesterday that they will submit a fee proposal to proceed.

We are not entirely clear on the exact order of the next steps, but assuming the traffic study concurs with the engineers' views, this should then head to the respective traffic committees of Lane Cove and Willoughby (the RMS-led ones) for approval. Willoughby has already approved doing this, so it should be a minimal issue; we are not sure about Lane Cove but will follow up. In any case, it's slow progress but heading in the right direction
