Proposed Heritage Conservation Area

A report will go to Willoughby Council (Item 18.3.2/3) on Monday 27th August 2018 proposing to rezone properties to a Conservation Area. There are usually diverse views as to whether a Heritage Conservation Zoning is a good or a bad thing. At the outset, most people do not understand what it all means.

Your property will be affected by the changed zoning.

As an individual or a group you may wish to request Councilors to defer any decision relating to this matter until after a **PUBLIC MEETING** is organised by Council to explain to residents the benefits and disadvantages of a Heritage Conservation Area zoning.
